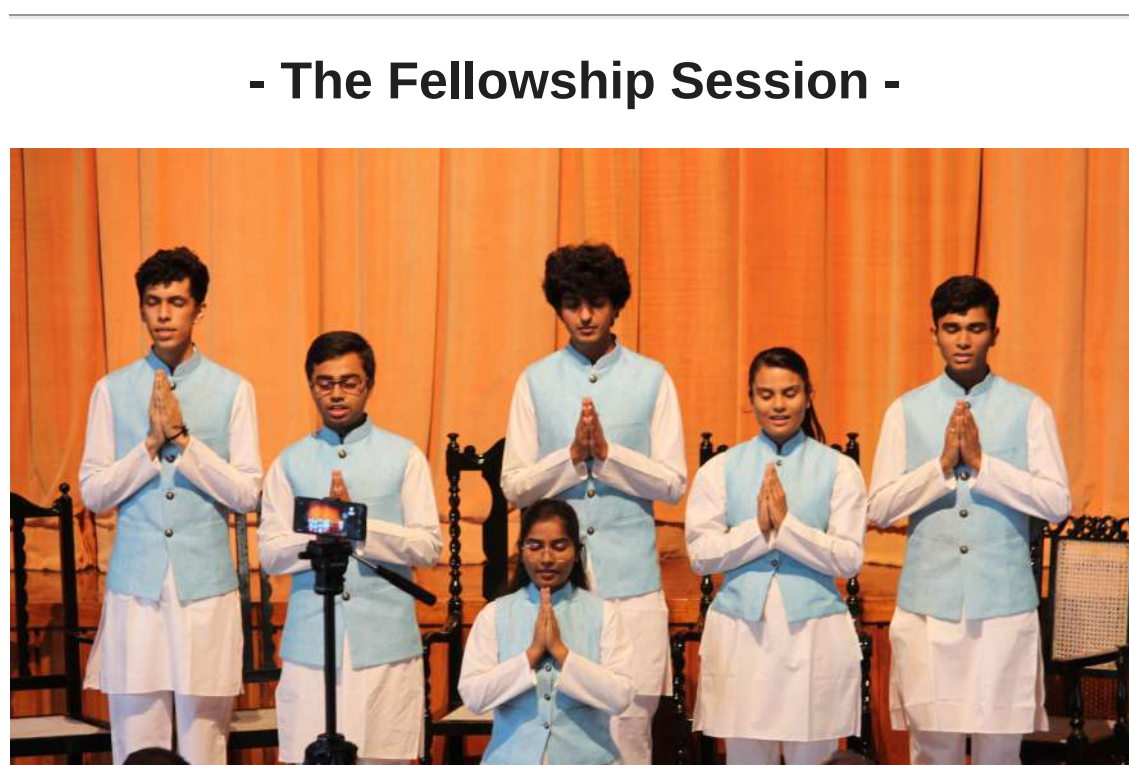
## - The May W'shop Begins! -

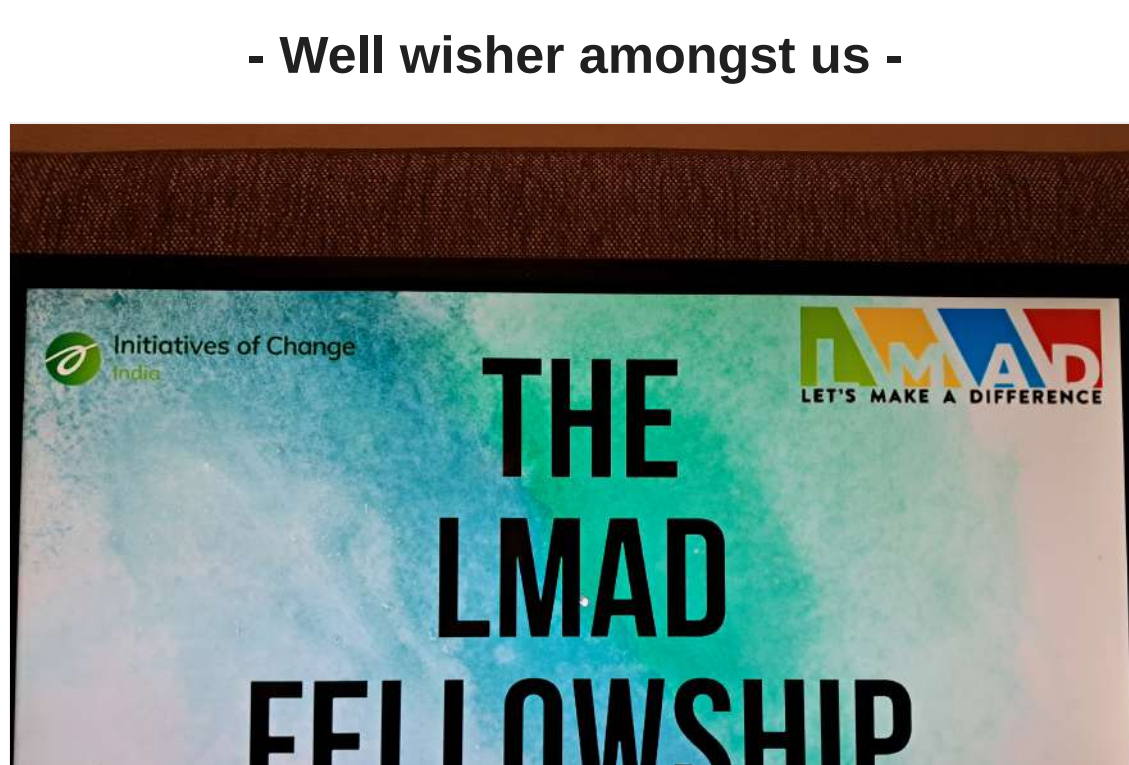

## - The Fellowship Session -



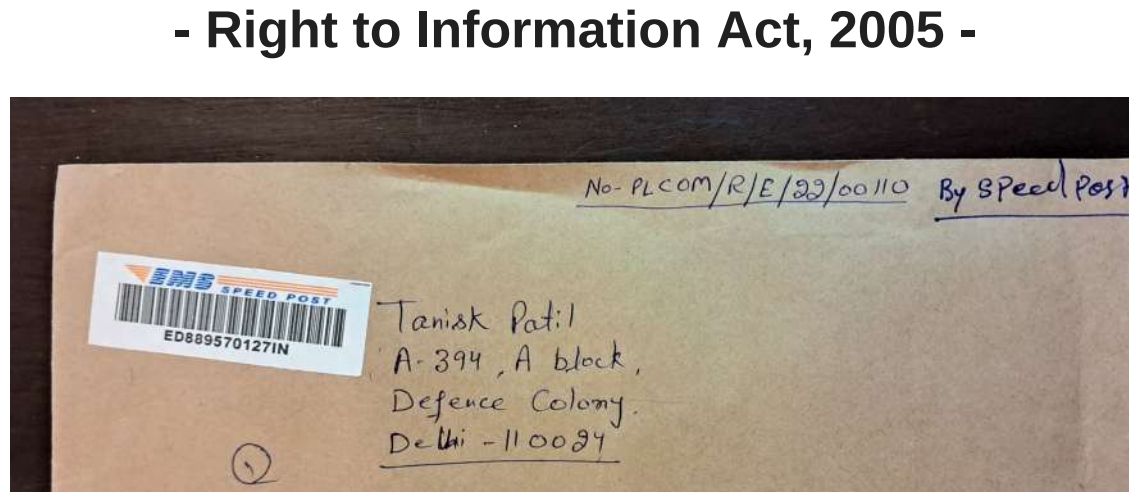
